The *National Greenhouse and Energy Reporting (NGER) Regulations* are now in force with the first reporting period almost completed, with reports due by 31 October 2009. Despite this, there remains uncertainty regarding the precise nature of the obligations under this legislation for industry and councils, and who these obligations apply to.

The AEBN briefing will provide participants with a clear understanding of your obligations and will demonstrate how Industry and Councils should be gathering and collating data, as well as how this data should be entered into the Federal Government's reporting database, *Online System for Comprehensive Activity Reporting (OSCAR)*.

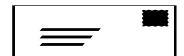
