Environment Protection Authority Victoria (EPA) is the state's independent environmental regulator.


We work with community, industry, business and governments to prevent and reduce the harmful effects of pollution and waste on Victoria's environment and people.

A focus on prevention of harm













Harm to human health or the environment



Preventing harm by making risk management a positive legal obligation



1970 Act focus

Protecting human health and the environment by punishing polluters that cause harm

Refinements to the framework

Refinements made since 1 July 2021

- several legislative instruments including a waste determination and a waste designation
- Amendments to the Act to clarify and refine various powers, functions and processes
- Amendments to the Regulations use of waste tyres to weigh down silage, single use plastic ban (from February 2023)

Further changes ahead


- further amendments to the Regulations noise from wind turbines
- Waste designation transport and storage of used lead-acid batteries

Focus of the first 12 months

- Activities that pose a significant risk to the environment and human health
- Promoting an understanding and building knowledge of:
 - New laws and duties
 - Hazard and risk identification and management
- For permission holders:
 - Support the transition
 - Compliance with conditions
 - Risk management and monitoring plans



Statement of regulatory intent

- ✓ Raise awareness and build knowledge
- ✓ Work with industry on what compliance looks like
- ✓ If we see non-compliance, our response will be measured and proportionate
- ✓ Deliberate and criminal non-compliance will be taken seriously


Guidance for business




Preventative inspections



Waste Tracker

- Waste Tracker is EPA's system to track
- reportable priority waste.
- There are now +6,000 users of Waste Tracker
- Since 1 July, more than 425,000 waste records have been completed using Waste Tracker.
- Our focus is shifting from onboarding to compliance.

Reflections

- First 12 months was as expected, based on experience with introduction of OHS laws 10 years ago
- Variable knowledge of environmental regulation and risk management
- Most businesses want to do the right thing...but bad actors exist
- Increased focus and changed behavior particularly in relation to General Environmental Duty and waste duties
- Continue to learn from and review implementation of new environment protection framework
- EPA to continue to work with business to work with each other to build state of knowledge
- Precedent setting though the courts to occur
