

## Dangerous Goods (Storage and Handling) Regulations 2022

## Quick reference guide

The Dangerous Goods (Storage and Handling) Regulations 2022 (Storage and Handling Regulations) will commence on 26 November 2022.

The Storage and Handling Regulations, made under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1985*, set out the legal duties for manufacturers and suppliers of dangerous goods or suspected dangerous goods, and for occupiers of premises where dangerous goods are stored or handled.

The Storage and Handling Regulations will replace the Dangerous Goods (Storage and Handling) Regulations 2012, which expire on 27 November 2022.

The majority of changes incorporated into the Storage and Handling Regulations have been to modernise and simplify language. The structure has also been amended to align with modern drafting practices. An overview of the changes to the number and names of regulations, as well as changes to the structure, that have been incorporated in to the new regulations is below.
